**WHO** — For boys and girls ages 4 – 12. Children will be divided into separate age groups. *PLUS:* children under 6 can come half day, leaving at 12:30, for \$50.

**WHAT** — The themes of **UNITY** and **JOYFULNESS** will be taught through music, arts and crafts, games, drama, stories, service projects, and study of selected Holy Writings from all the world's religions. Multiple aspects of unity will be addressed — family, community, world, religious, racial, etc. Children should bring lunch and a swim suit and towel for water play each day.

Morning and afternoon snacks will be provided; please bring a sack lunch.

**WHERE** — Centrally located near the former Austin airport in the Austin Bahá'í Center, at 2215 E.M. Franklin Avenue. Take Manor Road to the airport entrance, turn right onto Pershing and make an immediate left onto E.M. Franklin Avenue. The center is on the left. **WHEN** — Monday through Friday, June 6-10, 2011, 9:00am to 4:00pm. The children will present a program for their families, friends and the community on Friday, June 10 at 3:00pm. Children's artwork produced during Unity Camp will be displayed for all to enjoy.

**HOW** — Registration forms are available at the Bahá'í Center or may be downloaded from our website at [www.austinbahai.org](http://www.austinbahai.org). The camp fee is \$100 for the first child in a family and \$75 for each additional child in the same family. A discount of \$25 per child for registrations mailed before May 30. A minimum of \$20 must accompany registration form. Full or partial scholarships are available and applications must be received by May 30.

**STAFF** — Qualified teachers or counselors will lead each group, assisted by activity directors and junior counselors.
